

A Multi-Engine rating qualifies you to fly an Aircraft with more than one engine. Elite Aviation Academy Flight Training Centre uses several Beechcraft Baron BE55 Aircraft, powered by two 260 HP fuel-injected Continental engines. (To view the aircraft visit our Advanced Training Fleet).

Part of the Multi-Engine Training can be done on a Simulator. It is a safe and more cost-effective alternative. (

To obtain a Multi-Engine Rating you will need a PPL with a minimum of 150 total flying hours.

All Multi-Engine conversions are given by our highly skilled and qualified senior Grade II Multi-Engine Instructors, all of whom have an excess of 1500 hours flying experience.

Multi-Engine training consists of:

- A Technical Examination on the Multi-Engine aircraft.
- A minimum of 7 Hours Multi-Engine training towards a conversion on the Aircraft, of which 2 hours can be done on our Flight Simulator.
- 20 Hours of Instrument Training (of which 5 hours can be done on our Simulator, 5 hours can be done on a Single-Engine Aircraft and 10 hours can be done on a Multi-Engine aircraft.)

The duration of the Course usually takes 3 to 4 weeks, depending on your finances and training performance.
